PEEL DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD

Key Statistics:

- ▶ Funding has increased by 68.5% since 2003 to \$1,357,951,248.
- ▶ Enrolment has increased 14.6% or 17,903 students.
- ▶ Per-pupil funding increased by \$3,088 to \$9,657 per student.

GRANTS

- ▶ Per-pupil funding increased by \$3,300 to \$10,144 per student.
